We use the verb to be to talk about ages, nationalities, colours, prices, occupations, the time, feelings and states

## + Affirmative

I	<b>am / 'm</b>	I am a student.
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You We They	<b>are / 're</b>	You / We / They are friends.
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She He It	<b>is / 's</b>	She / He / It is old.
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## - Negative

I	<b>am not</b>	I am not a vet.
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You We They	<b>are not aren't</b>	You / We / They aren't cousins.
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She He It	<b>is not isn't</b>	She / He / It isn't young.
